AD HOC COMMITTEES

The Board, whenever it deems it necessary, may appoint a committee composed of citizens, employees and/or students to assist the Board. Committees formed by the Board are ad hoc committees. The Board will clearly state the duties and purposes of the ad hoc committee.

Ad Hoc committees are advisory in nature and have no duty or responsibility other than that specifically stated by the Board. The committee will automatically dissolve upon the delivery of its final recommendation to the Board or upon completion of the duties outlined by the Board. The Board will receive the report of the committee for consideration. The Board retains the authority to make a final decision on the issue. The committee may be subject to the open meetings law.

The method for selection of committee members will be determined by the Board. When possible, and when the necessary expertise required allows, the committee members will be representative of the school district community and will consider the various viewpoints on the issue. The Board may designate a Board member and the Superintendent to serve on an ad hoc committee. The committee will select its own chairperson, unless the Board designates otherwise.
