SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education of the Waterloo Community School District derives its legal status from the Constitution of the State of Iowa and the statutes enacted by the Iowa General Assembly. The Board of Education acts as an agent of the State in setting policy and providing general direction for the school district in accordance with the laws of Iowa, policies and regulations of the Waterloo Community School District and the expressed will of the electorate.

The Board of Education will consist of seven members who will each be elected for a term of four years or will complete the unexpired term of a regularly elected member.

Four members shall be elected from director districts and three shall be elected at-large.
