NEW BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

A new member, or any person designated for appointment as a new member of the Board, is to be afforded the Board's and staff's fullest measures of courtesy and cooperation. Board and staff shall make every feasible effort to assist the new member to become fully informed about the Board's functions, policies, procedures, and problems.

The Superintendent, in cooperation with Board members, may schedule a special work session(s) or other meetings or consultations for the purpose of orienting members to their responsibilities, the Board's method of operating and District policies and procedures.

The new member will be provided with copies of all appropriate publications and aids, including the Board policy manual, if desired, and publications of the state and national school board associations.
