The Board of Education selects a Superintendent of Schools and delegates to him/her the authority for carrying out the policies, plans and administrative details necessary to insure the effective operation of the District.

The Superintendent is the main advisor to the Board on all matters concerning the District. The Superintendent will furnish reports, information, and recommendations, both upon the request of the Board and upon self-directed initiative.
