QUORUM

Action by the board regarding the affairs of the school district may be taken only when a quorum, a majority of the board members, is in attendance at the board meeting. While in person participation is encouraged, board members may participate in board meetings by phone or electronically, providing each member can hear and be heard in real time by all members present as well as the public. The board secretary shall record in the minutes when a board member participates by phone or electronically.

While board members are encouraged to attend board meetings, four members shall constitute a quorum and are sufficient number to transact business of the school corporation. The adjournment of a meeting may be executed without a quorum.

An affirmative vote of a majority of the votes cast shall be sufficient to pass a motion or take action unless law or board policy requires a vote of a greater number.

It is the responsibility of each board member to regularly attend board meetings.
