

SCHOOL BOARD LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM

The Board of Education, as an agent of the State, shall operate within the bounds of State and Federal laws and regulations affecting public education. To meet its responsibilities to the residents and students of the District, the Board may, in conjunction with other districts or agencies, work for the passage of new laws designed to advance quality education and for the repeal or modification of existing laws which impede this cause.

The Board may appoint from among its members and employees, individuals who will represent the official position of the District to state and federal legislative bodies and educational agencies, as needed.
