INSTRUCTIONAL AND LIBRARY MATERIALS INSPECTION AND DISPLAY

Parents and other members of the school district community shall be permitted to view the instructional and library materials used by the students. All instructional materials, including teacher's manuals, films, tapes or other supplementary material which will be used in connection with any survey, analysis, or evaluation as part of any federally funded programs must be available for inspection by parents.

The instructional materials must be viewed on school district premises except in special circumstances as determined by the Associate Superintendent for Teaching and Learning. Copies may be obtained according to board policy.

The district will publish on the district's website a comprehensive list of all books available to students in media centers operated by the school district.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to develop administrative regulations regarding the inspection of instructional materials.
