TRANSPORTATION OF OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS BY RECEIVING DISTRICTS

The Board of Education will consider formal requests by Boards of receiving school districts to enter the Waterloo Schools for the purpose of transporting students approved for the State Open Enrollment Program.

Any agreement to allow a bus from another district to enter the Waterloo Schools to transport Open Enrollment students will require Board approval of the sending and receiving Districts and Central Rivers Area Education Agency, as set forth by the State Department of Education. All such agreements shall be in writing in accordance with procedures developed by the District.

The Board of Education reserves the right to approve or deny transportation requests based upon guidelines established by the District.
