

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS AND PARENT CONFERENCES

Students shall receive a progress report at minimum at the end of each grading period. Students who are not meeting expectations, and their parents, shall be notified at mid-term in order to have an opportunity to improve the student's performance before the end of the grading period.

Parent-teacher conferences will be held twice per year, once during the first semester and again in the second semester.

Parents, teachers, or principals may request conferences for students in grades pre-kindergarten through twelve in addition to the scheduled conference time. Parents and students are encouraged to discuss the student's progress or other matters with the student's teacher.
