PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students in grades one through twelve shall be required to participate in physical education courses unless they are excused by the school principal.

Students may be excused from physical education courses if the student presents a written statement from a doctor stating that such activities could be injurious to the health of the student, or the student has been exempted because of a conflict with the student's religious belief.

Students in grades 9-12 may also be excused from physical education classes if:

- the student is enrolled in academic courses not otherwise available, or maintaining seven academic courses, or
- the student has obtained a physical education waiver for a semester because the student is actively involved in an athletic program.

Twelfth grade students may also be excused from physical education courses if the student is enrolled in a cooperative, work study or other educational program authorized by the school which requires the student's absence from school.

A parent or guardian must submit a written statement requesting or approving a physical education exemption for their student.
