CAREER & TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Preparing students for college and careers is one goal of the educational program. Career & Technical education will be infused into the high school education program through career and technical education. The Career & Technical Advisory Committees will be composed of local business professionals and representatives of community organizations that will provide a wide range of resources to help further the educational and technical needs of students for future employment or college.

The Executive Director of Professional Technical Education shall provide the support for the Career & Technical Advisory Committee. The Executive Director of Professional Technical Education will direct the career and technical development for the Waterloo Community School District. The Executive Director of Professional Technical Education will also assist in identifying community members to service on committee and help to facilitate meetings.

The Board of Education shall receive a report and budget recommendations from the Career & Technical Advisory Committees and supplemental reports, as requested.
