A districtwide assessment program will be conducted annually in accordance with the provisions of Administrative Regulation 603.7-R.

Assessment information will be used instructionally to diagnose learning needs and to improve achievement. Using a data-driven decision-making approach instructional leaders and teachers will use the data to plan teaching/learning/intervention strategies and to assist in the development of appropriate curriculum offerings.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent, in conjunction with Education Service Center administrators and the principals, to develop administrative regulations regarding this policy.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent/designee to review and approve the evaluation and assessment program.
