RESEARCH PROJECTS AND SURVEYS

In view of the District's size and demographics, the District frequently is requested to participate in a wide range of research studies (including research projects, surveys, questionnaires, etc.). In order to monitor the number of studies conducted, all agencies and individuals will submit requests to do research to the Associate Superintendent for Educational Services. These requests, in turn, will be processed by the appropriate personnel in accordance with the approved procedure for evaluation of research requests.

Approved studies must be of value to the District's educational program or to a specific interest of a division and shall not violate the privacy of students or citizens of the District as set forth in federal or state statute or Board of Education's policies. Additional considerations to be utilized as part of the approval process for all research requests shall include any loss of instructional time, required staff time, and the District receipt of research study results demonstrating an impact on teaching practice and learning results.
