## PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE PROGRAM

The Board of Education shall maintain a comprehensive property and casualty insurance program that will provide adequate coverage in the event of loss or damage of the school buildings and equipment.

A private appraisal agency may be retained upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools for inventory and appraisal value services to enable the Board of Education to maintain a comprehensive property and casualty insurance program.

The Board of Education shall review the property and casualty insurance program of the school district periodically to insure adequate coverage of the program. Such review may be made annually, but such review must be made within every three-year period.

The Superintendent of Schools, after consultation with other administrative personnel, the school district's appraisal agency, and the school district's insurance agency, shall provide the data and shall make recommendations concerning the school district's program of property and casualty insurance.
